The Ministry of Commerce, Business Development, Investment and Consumer Affairs in collaboration with the Embassy of the Republic of China (Taiwan) will be hosting a Business Delegation from the New Jersey Taiwanese Chamber of Commerce from February 01-04, 2015.

The main objectives of this activity are to provide an opportunity for the visiting business delegation to network with the local private sector as well as to explore areas to invest in Saint Lucia. The areas of interest by the visiting business delegation are banking, insurance, restaurant and catering, recycling (paper, plastic, scrap metal) hotel properties and manufacturing (plastics, chemical, fiber products, film). This visit follows a similar visit last year by a delegation of Taiwanese business persons who were based in Miami.
