Name Search Form is prepared at the Department of Commerce (SEDU/SBDC) and is to be submitted to the Registry of Companies and Intellectual Property (ROCIP).

Note: Applicant must bring his/her National Identification (ID).

- 2 Client Intake Form is filled.
- 3 Approval of Name Search is done at ROCIP.
- 4 Approved Name Search returned to SEDU/SBDC and forwarded to the Department's Legal Officer for processing.
- Please note that processing time can be up to three weeks (15 working days) and will require scheduled consultation with the Department's Legal Officer.
- 6 **Fees for filing: \$912.50**
 - *Please note that legal officer will inform you when payment must be made. Payment is done at ROCIP.
- 7 Return the Incorporation Certificate to SEDU/SBDC for a copy to be made for the records.
- 8 The Incorporation Certificate should be brought to:
 - Inland Revenue (IRD) to be issued a Tax Account Number
 - National Insurance Corporation (NIC) for employer registration
