The Minister of Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3(1) of the External Trade Act 1968, No. 5, makes the following Order:

Short title

1. This Order may be cited as the External Trade (Restricted Imports) Order, 1996.

Cholera bacteria test, for seafoods from specified countries

2. Seafoods, originating from the countries listed in the First Schedule shall be subject to random sample testing for cholera bacteria, on importation.

Requirement of evidence of origin.

3. Goods supported by evidence of origin in accordance with Schedule II of the Common Market Annex to the Treaty of Chaguaramas shall not require a licence when originating from countries which are members of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS).

Restricted imports

- **4.** (1) The items listed in the Second, Third and Fourth Schedules shall not be imported without a licence granted under section 4 of the External Trade Act, 1968.
- (2) A licence is required to import all the items listed in the Second Schedule when such items originate from any country which is not a member of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States or the Caribbean Common market.
- (3) A licence is required to import all the items listed in the Third Schedule, when such items originate from any country which is a member of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States or the Caribbean Common market.
- (4) A licence is required to import all the items listed in the Fourth Schedule when such items originate from any country which is not a member of the Organisation of the Eastern Caribbean States.
